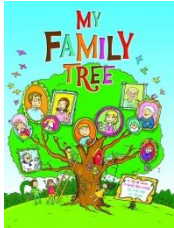

#### Task 1 - Our Support Networks?

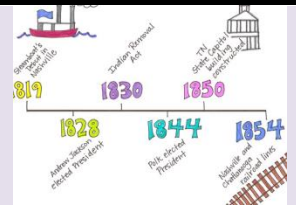
At the minute, our families are super important to help us to feel safe. Some members of the family are living with you and others you might just be able to speak to on the phone. These support networks are so
